## NAAC PEER TEAM VISIT CYCLE 2023



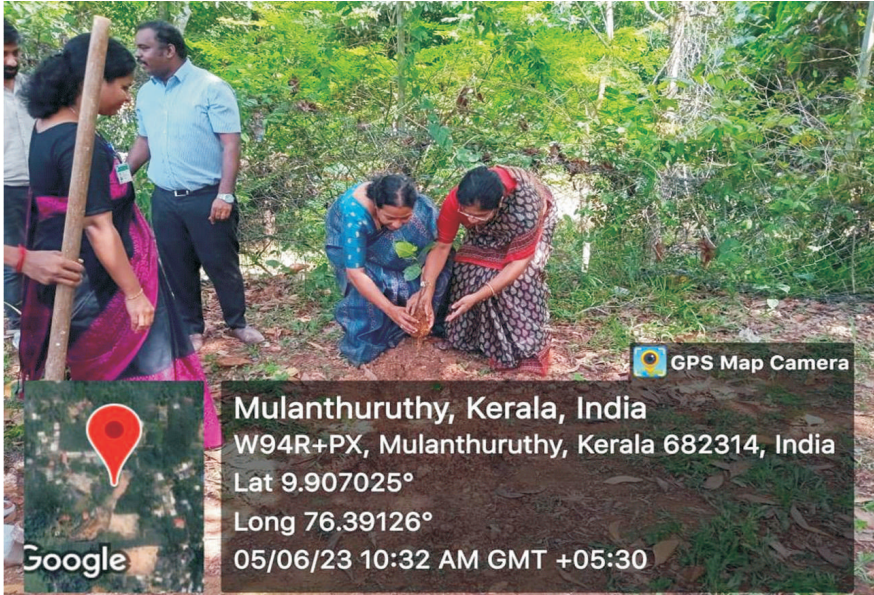

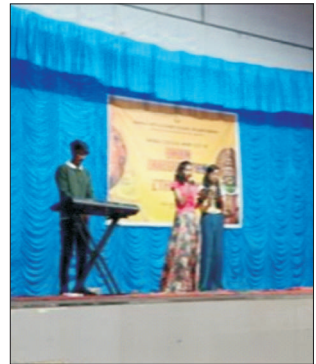
