X'MAS CHEER



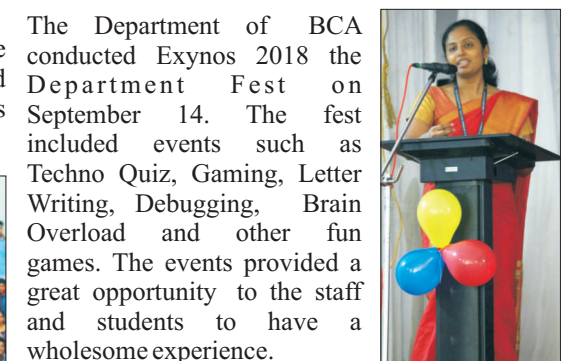
The college celebrated Christmas with great fervour. Carols and X'mas Tree decoration competitions added to the festive mood.
