### **Brief Report**

In August 2018, Kerala was hit by one of the worst floods in its history. The floods, caused by heavy monsoon rains, affected millions of people, destroyed homes and infrastructure, and claimed many lives. In response to the disaster, the Nirmala Arts and Science College in Mulanthuruthy opened a flood relief camp to provide temporary shelter to the affected population. The camp began on August 13th, 2018, and remained open for several weeks. The organizers of the camp, including the college administration, local government officials, and volunteers from various organizations, worked tirelessly to ensure that the needs of the flood victims were met.

The camp provided basic necessities such as food, water, and medical assistance. The college premises were used as the primary shelter, with makeshift beds and basic facilities set up for the residents.
