POLICY FOR SOLID AND LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT

The college is committed to the principle of sustainability and actively encourages environmentally acceptable practises for the disposal of solid, liquid, and electronic waste. The college implements the following policies to address this issue:

- The College uses different coloured litterbins for different types of waste, namely blue for liquid waste and green for solid waste.
- of different colour for different types of wastes that is blue for wet waste and Green for solid waste.
- The housekeeping staff removes litter like as bottles, cans, papers, and plastic from litterbins and open spaces and then delivers it to the authorised workers of Mulanthuruthy Grampanchayat for recycling or disposal.
- The canteen solid waste and other biodegradable wastes are used to produce compost manure, which can be used for organic farming and gardening
- Waste water from wash basins and restrooms is drained through a well-maintained drainage system.
- All toilets are having septic tank facility.
- When making new purchases of office equipment and accessories like Photostat machines / printers / UPS / batteries / etc, an exchange system can be followed.
- The E-waste collected is stored in a store room; some items are upcycled to make handmade articles; the balance items are disposed annually for their safe recycling.
